- **Via Miramar Beach** - From US 41 in the Moorings, head west on Harbour Drive, Left on Gulf Shore Blvd N to Via Miramar.*

Parking Ticket Fines

A handicap ticket violation fine is \$250 all other violation fines are \$100. Both types of tickets have a \$2 surcharge added for the sole purpose of funding the school crossing guard program, therefore the total cost for a handicap parking violation is \$252 and the total cost for all other parking violations is \$102. Timely payment of a parking fine (excluding a handicap violation) will reduce the cost of the ticket. The chart below will assist you with the fines/surcharge total cost.



Total Ticket Cost	Payment Timeframe	Reduced Fine
\$102	Less than 10 days	\$77
\$102	Greater than 10 days	\$102

Resident Beach Parking Permit

All Collier County property taxpayers and full-time residents are eligible to receive an annual permit to park at all City of Naples and Collier County beaches free of charge.



Residents of the City of Naples may obtain their free annual beach parking permit by visiting City Hall at 735 8th Street South. Proof of property ownership will be required.

- Residents must provide proof of residency, specifically, a drivers license and original vehicle registration, both with the same name and address within the City limits.
- Non-residents who own property within the City limits must provide a copy of their Collier County tax statement reflecting an address in the City limits, as well as their current drivers license and vehicle registration.

Collier County residents (outside the City limits) can obtain their free Collier County Beach Parking Permit at most of the Collier County Community Parks.

Permit Placement

Beach parking permits must be **firmly affixed** to the inside of the windshield in the lower left corner of the driver's side of the vehicle. **They are not transferable.** Remove old permits when adhering the new permit. Vehicles with valid beach permits may park free in metered spaces at City and County beaches, and in any space designated as requiring a beach permit.



Beach parking permits are valid for one year only. Observe the month that is punched on your beach parking sticker, and remember to replace the permit before the month ends.



Beach Parking Rules

All of the parking areas have signs to assist visitors in understanding the parking rules.

Most importantly, if the beach end has a Beach Parking by Resident Only sign, **DO NOT PARK THERE** if you are a non-resident of Collier County.

Beach Parking Rules:

- Please Help Keep Your Beach Clean– No Littering.
- No glass, animals, or fires allowed on the beach.
- All parking spaces require a payment or Beach Parking Permit.
- Park in Marked Spaces Only
- NO Parking 11 pm to 5 am.
- No parking of trailers, trucks, recreational vehicles or buses within one block of the beach.
- Violators will be towed at owner's expense.



Note: Lowdermilk Park closes at Dusk.



Parking Meters

Visitors or customers without a Beach Parking Pass should use Beach ends with a multi-space parking pay station listed under Visitor Parking. Parking is **not free**, it is \$3.00 per hour.



The pay stations are conveniently located near the entrance to the parking area or beach access point and are easy to use.

The machines accept coins, American Express, Discover, VISA, and MasterCard.

Every five minutes of parking costs \$.25, or a total of \$3.00 per hour. A minimum of \$1.50 is required. When you exit your vehicle, make a note of

your parking space number, you will need to enter that number into the pay station.

Read Carefully and follow the three easy steps 1) Press Keypad to Wake the Pay Station 2) Follow the directional prompts, 3) Make Payment.

Once your payment has been accepted the screen will display the time your payment will expire.

You can also **Extend-by-Phone** by adding your cell phone number at the conclusion of your transaction. This feature requires noninterrupted cellular service through the time you have paid and when the meter expires.



This will notify you 10-15 minutes prior to the expiration of your meter and will allow you to extend your meter's time, to avoid any parking violation. You must text back prior to the time the meter expires. **You cannot renew/add time after the meter has expired.**
