

**FIRST EXTENSION OF AGREEMENT  
FOR SERVICES  
DISPOSAL OF BIO-SOLIDS TO A COMPOSTING FACILITY**

*28<sup>th</sup>* **THIS FIRST EXTENSION** of the Agreement is made and entered into this *December* day of ~~November~~ 2017 by and between the **City of Naples** and **Prolime Corporation**.

**WHEREAS**, the City and the Contractor entered into that certain Agreement on **October 17, 2012** for **Disposal of Bio-Solids to a Composting Facility (Bid No. 12-059 [059-12] and Clerk Tracking No. 12-00061)** for the City of Naples; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties desire to extend the Original Agreement so that the Contractor will provide said services for an additional year with an allowed First Renewal 2015-2016 price increase of (3) three percent and with a \$30.00 disposal fee reduction effective January 1, 2018 that will be paid directly by the City of Naples to Lee County, both indicated on **Exhibit-B** which is attached and made a part of this First Extension; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager is authorized by City Council pursuant to Section 2-667 (7)(e), Naples City Code, to extend this Agreement;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is hereby acknowledged and agreed that the Original Agreement is hereby extended **from October 17, 2017 through October 16, 2018 with one, 1-year extension available.**

**WHEREAS**, the City and the Contractor have caused this Amendment to be duly executed by their duly authorized officers.
